Content	<p>Development cooperation (DC) actors not only have to deal with fundamental criticism of development policy - meaning in general, questioning the instruments - but are also confronted with numerous challenges in their day-to-day work. When planning and implementing projects, for example, questions arise as to how a sustainable impact can be ensured and how certain approaches such as the do-no-harm approach and gender aspects can be taken into account.</p> <p>Based on the three courses freely chosen in the module, students select a topic and a target region for the design of a specific project proposal in development cooperation. To this end, they develop project management methods during the seminar and apply these to their project ideas in small groups. The proposal is presented and discussed in the examination.</p>
Learning Objectives/ Learning Outcomes	Acquisition of project management methods in development cooperation, application of these to specific project examples, transfer of previous knowledge of development cooperation to project development
